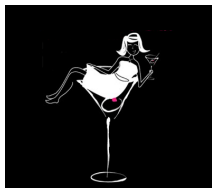

This is the 'headline news' of what I think the job entails. Obviously I am more than willing to talk to anyone to "fill in any gaps" and answer any questions.

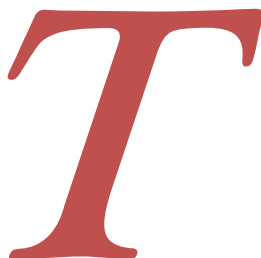
